



## Uniform Policy

Our uniform shows that we are part of the Sacks Morasha school community and we wish to ensure all children represent the school by being smart and keeping within the ethos of the school. We expect our pupils to wear their uniform with pride.

We have the highest expectations from our pupils with regards to school uniform and appearance, and strongly believe that our high standards promote positive behaviour, support effective teaching and learning, and contribute to the ethos of the school.

We have refined our uniform policy for September 2017 to ensure that standards are high, yet costs remain reasonable.

### School uniform and appearance

We have a straightforward school uniform and we encourage all our children to wear it smartly.

Uniform must be kept in good repair, be clean and have no rips or tears in it. Uniform must be checked on a regular basis by the pupil's parents/carer to ensure it is suitable for wear and in a good state of repair.

As you will see from the list below, the Sacks Morasha logo appears only on the jumper, cardigan, cap, book bag/rucksack, PE sweatshirt and PE bag. These items, with the school kippah, can **only** be purchased from Uniform4Kids at 1103–05 Finchley Road, Temple Fortune, NW11 0QB or [www.uniform4kids.com](http://www.uniform4kids.com)

Uniform4Kids also supplies all other items of our uniform, but in order to keep costs down non-logo items can also be purchased in supermarkets and elsewhere. Please always ensure that you adhere to the required style.

All items of uniform must be labelled.

### Girls' winter uniform

- Light blue polo shirt.  
While we do not have a preferred supplier, the style of the polo shirt should be the one in the link below and as supplied by Uniform4Kids, i.e. with a straight collar (no frills) and 2–4 buttons in the front:
- school cardigan must still be worn.
- **For Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 girls only:** Grey pinafore dress (not skirt), on the knee or below. We do not have a preferred supplier, but the pinafore must be plain and have no adornment or embossed design.
- **For Years 3–6 girls only:** Grey pleated skirt (not pinafore), on the knee or below. We do not have a preferred supplier, but the style of the skirt should be like the one in this link, i.e. with box pleats but no other details, and as supplied by Uniform4Kids:
- Sacks Morasha school cap – to be kept in school.
- Black or grey socks/tights.
- Sensible black school shoes, not trainers.

### **Girls' summer uniform (may be worn in the Summer Term)**

- Light blue and white gingham summer dress, on the knee or below.
- White socks.
- Sensible black shoes, not trainers or sandals.

### **Boys' winter uniform**

- Light blue polo shirt.  
We do not have a preferred supplier, but the style of the polo shirt should be the one in the link below, and as supplied by Uniform4Kids, i.e. with a straight collar and 2–4 buttons in the front:
- Sacks Morasha jumper – must be worn even when wearing a long-sleeved blue polo shirt.
- Grey trousers.
- Black or grey socks.
- School cap – to be kept in school.
- Sacks Morasha kippah.
- Tzitzit.
- Sensible black school shoes, not trainers.

### **Boys' summer uniform (may be worn in the Summer Term)**

- Grey shorts if preferred
- All other items are the same as the winter uniform list above.

### **PE uniform**

We require our pupils to change into their PE (physical education) for PE activities.

All pupils need an appropriately labelled PE kit consisting of the following:

- Sacks Morasha royal blue hooded top
- royal blue jogging bottoms
- royal blue long, lightweight shorts (for boys and girls), available from Sports Direct:

- white plain t-shirt
- Sacks Morasha royal blue PE bag (Havasak)
- plain black or blue plimsolls or trainers.

If a child does not have their PE kit in school when it is needed, they will miss PE lessons and a letter will be sent home.

### **Jewellery and make-up**

- If girls have pierced ears, ONE pair of discreet studs may be worn.
- No other jewellery is permitted to be worn or brought into school.
