I have recently spoke with the Rt Hon Nick Gibb MP, Minister of State for School Standards, who has informed me that, this year, Sacks Morasha Jewish Primary School have shown an increase to 87% of pupils achieving the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics.

I am therefore writing to congratulate you on such a fantastic achievement. This increase is something for which both staff and pupils can be rightly proud.

Thanks to the hard work of teachers and pupils nationally, who have adjusted well to the reformed KS2 tests, the national average has increased from 61% to 64% this year. These more demanding KS2 tests have set a higher standard in schools, bringing England's primary school curriculum closer to the curricula common in countries with the most successful education systems.

Thank you for your continuing contribution to the local community.
