

Literacy

Book: Poems

Key Skills:

- To develop a pleasure in reading, motivation to read, vocabulary and understanding by learning to appreciate poems.
- Ensure letter formation is correct and address accordingly.

Ideas: Class poem, shape poems, act poems.

Numeracy

Topics: Multiples of 2, 5 and 10. measurement of length, height, weight and volume.

Key Skills:

- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.
- Compare, describe and solve practical problems for lengths and heights.
- Begin to record mass/ weight, capacity and volume.
- Use subject related vocabulary to describe the measurement.

Ideas: Use of rulers, metre sticks, measuring cups and scales.

Science

Topic: Plants

Key Skills:

- Perform simple tests.
- Gather and record data to help in answering questions.
- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

Ideas: plant tomatoes and watch them grow in different environments.

Computing

Topic: Making food instructions- algorithms

Key Skills:

- Understanding what algorithms are.

Ideas: Write instructions to make a jam sandwich.

Topic: Teddy Bear's Picnic

Key Skills: Research food sources and processes

Ideas: Children will learn about picnic food, farm to fork and food packaging design. They will also learn food safety skills and cooking skills.

IVRIT

Topic: Plural verbs

Key Skills:

- Say words and short phrases / sentences in response to what they see and hear.
- Answer simple questions and give basic information.
- Use adjectives correctly in sentences.
- Use masculine and feminine genders appropriately.
- Use new vocabulary through role play.
- Understand familiar spoken words and phrases.

Key Skills:

- Talk, write and draw about aspects of the past.
- Sort artefacts from then and now.
- Ask and answer relevant questions about the past.
- Identify some similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods.

Ideas: Trip to the Tower of London,

PSHE and FBV

Topic: Feelings and emotions

Key Skills:

- Learn to discuss how we are feeling and why.
- Look for ways to help us feel better.
- Develop an understand of what makes us feel a certain way.

Ideas: circle time, games, roll play.

PE

Topic: Football

Key Skills: Spatial awareness, control of the ball.

Ideas: Mini tournament and relay races.
