

Literacy

Book: 'Shackleton's Journey'

Key Skills: Write effectively for a range of purposes and audiences selecting the appropriate form and drawing independently on what they have read as models for their writing. Select language that shows good awareness of the reader. Describe settings, characters and atmosphere. Integrate dialogue into the narrative to convey character and to advance the action.

Select vocabulary/grammatical structures that reflect what the writing requires. Propose changes to vocabulary, grammar and punctuation.

Ideas: Retell the introduction in your own words and compare with similar texts - Reading journals, Text marking, Story mapping, Character description, List poetry, Letter writing Instructions and Log writing.
